### SPECIAL HOURS:

**Adult Swim:** The pool will be open for adult swim (18 and older) at 6:00 a.m. - 7:00 a.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays June 15<sup>th</sup> through August 21<sup>st</sup>.

**Swim Team:** May 25 to June 9 (weekdays only) the Lap pool (north) is closed from 4:45-7:00 p.m. due to swim team practice. The Wading pool and Dive pool (south) will be open to the members during that time. June 10 to July 10 (weekdays only) the Lap pool (north) is closed from 5:45-7:00 p.m. due to swim team practice. The Wading pool and Dive pool (south) will be open to the members during that time.

**Swim Meets:** The Lap pool will be open between 1:30p.m.-2:30p.m. on the following Saturdays due to swim team home meets. The Wading and Dive pool (south) will be open as normal during the meet:

### MEMBERSHIP:

Use of the Stonegate Village Metropolitan District and Lincoln Park Metropolitan District's swim facilities are available to residents of the District. A "resident" is defined as someone residing within the borders of the Stonegate Village Metropolitan District or Lincoln Park Metropolitan District and whose water bill reflects an assessment of the *Stonegate Village Metropolitan District*. Residents who occupy a rental property or multifamily dwelling must provide proof of residency (water bill and/or government issued ID).

### **MEMBERSHIP CARDS:**

- The District utilizes an electronic ID system and membership cards need to be validated every year.
- A Pool Identification Card is necessary to enter the pool area. Initial cards cost \$5.00 each and are issued to each person in the household 10 years and older.
- Before entering the pool area, residents **MUST PRESENT THEIR ID CARD TO THE GATE MONITOR – NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- **replacement membership cards** are available at the South Pool front desk for a fee of \$5.00 per card.

### **GUESTS:**

Use of the recreational facilities is a privilege afforded to residents. The facility is also available for use to resident's guests. Guests may be admitted only if **accompanied** by a resident. The resident is responsible for any fees and all conduct of their guests. A resident may not have more than six (6) guests at any one time (except for paid parties as described later). Each family is entitled to (10) guest passes at each pool free of charge. Guest passes will be kept electronically at the pool

Additional guest passes may be purchased **only** by providing a check payable to the *Stonegate Village Metropolitan District or Lincoln Park Metropolitan District*. The guest passes are available in increments of (10) for \$30.00 per card. Additional guest passes may be purchased by filling out a form available at the pool front desk and expire at the end of the season. Unused guest passes are non-refundable.

**The procedure for admitting guests is as follows:** Resident must accompany guests for the entire time they use the facility. The guest(s) will be asked to check in and the gate monitor will digitally record each guest entering the facility. The guest pass is good all day, however, if the guest leaves they must check in again when they return.

# Rules and Regulations

## **SWIMMING POOL RULES:**

***Membership cards are required for admission to the pool. Cards must be presented to the gate monitor to enter. A copy of your current water bill and driver's license is needed to update your pass every year. No exceptions.***

The Stonegate Village and Lincoln Park Metropolitan District have an agreement with M.P.M. Recreation, a professional pool management company, for the use of the swimming pools and swimming instruction.

## **POOL RULES**

1. No pushing or dunking.
2. No spitting or throwing of water.
3. No running.
4. NO GLASS CONTAINERS.
5. Do not restrict flow of water from spray features.
6. Do not sit on the spray features.
7. No diving in shallow areas.
8. No hanging on life lines or diving board.
9. No conduct detrimental to safety.
10. Obey the lifeguards at all times.
11. No unnecessary conversation with the lifeguards.

## **REGULATIONS**

1. The lifeguards have complete control over all activities in the pool area, and their instructions must be obeyed.
2. Unsafe behavior could result in the offender being asked to leave the pool area for the rest of the day. Pool privileges may be suspended for up to 48 hours by the lifeguards and for longer periods by the pool manager or Board of Directors, for infractions of pool rules and/or regulations.
3. Food is not permitted in or near the swimming pools. Trash must be disposed of in waste receptacles.
4. Children not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper while in the pools. No plastic diapers are permitted in the pools.
5. Small floating toys, rafts, rings, tubes or boards are allowed in the shallow end of the pool if not detrimental to safety and may be prohibited at the discretion of the lifeguards. ANY INFANT, TODDLER OR CHILD UNABLE TO SWIM MUST BE IN DIRECT CONTACT WITH AN ADULT IN THE WATER WHEN USING FLOTATION DEVICES. Large rafts, boats, etc. are not allowed in the pool at any time. Hard balls, such as tennis balls, may not be brought into the pool area.
6. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult or responsible baby-sitter 16 years or older. If the lifeguard determines the baby-sitter is not supervising the child satisfactorily, both will be asked to leave.
7. Animals are not allowed in the pool area or to be left tethered unattended at any time.
8. During regular pool hours, the pool will be cleared every hour for a 10 minute period. Adults 18 and over ONLY will be permitted to swim. An adult may take one non-swimming child 3 years or under into the water, but must remain in DIRECT CONTACT with the child. No children are allowed in the lap lanes during adult swim.
9. Proper swimming attire is required - swim suits only. No cutoffs may be worn into the pool.

10. Foul, abusive or excessively loud language will not be permitted.
11. All users of the pool shall be responsible for damage to property of the District caused by their family and/or guests.
12. Radios must be played so as not to be offensive to others. The lifeguards will determine acceptable volume levels. Failure to comply will result in loss of playing privileges.
13. Bicycles, skate boards, scooters, etc. are not allowed in the pool area. Roller blades must be removed before entering the pool area.
14. No person having an infectious or communicable disease or open wound is permitted in the pool.
15. Smoking and/or tobacco products are not permitted in the pool area.

### **DIVING BOARD**

1. Only one person on the diving board at a time.
2. Only one bounce is allowed.
3. No flips or back dives are permitted.
4. After going off the board, swim directly to the side and exit using the ladders.
5. Do not swim under the diving board.
6. Do not hang on the diving board.

### **SLIDE**

1. Only one person on the slide at a time.
2. After going down the slide, swim away from the area.
3. Do not swim under the slide.
4. Do not hang on the slide.

### **BABY POOL**

1. The baby pool is for use by children 6 years and under ONLY.
2. PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CHILDREN USING THE BABY POOL.

*Additional rules and regulations may be added at any time without notice at the discretion of the Stonegate Village and Lincoln Park Metropolitan District Board of Directors.*

## **SWIM LESSONS:**

Check out [www.mpmrecreation.com](http://www.mpmrecreation.com) for all your swim lesson needs. Online lesson registration opens Saturday, April 24. After June 5 Online registration will close and you must register at the front desk or by phone 303-770-9346. Group swim lessons are offered to members in two-week sessions and will begin the week of June 9th and continue through late July. The lessons are 1/2 hour long and are offered at 11:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. Monday – Thursday for a total of 8 lessons. In the event a make up lesson needs to be scheduled due to weather or holiday, the make up lesson will be on Fridays.

MPM Recreation group lessons use the Aqua Kickz learn to swim curriculum. An instructor to student ratio of 1 instructor to 3-4 students is used for maximum student growth. Group Lessons are offered for children ages three years and up. For children less than three years of age private lessons are available. The cost for group lessons is \$70.00 per child, per session. Payment is required before the session begins. Please make your checks payable to M.P.M. Recreation.

Private instruction may also be arranged. Private lessons are available for \$25 per half hour. Please see the pool front desk for details and sign ups. The Stonegate Village and Lincoln Park Metropolitan District has an agreement with M.P.M. Recreation & Management, a professional pool management company, for the use of the swimming pools and swimming instruction. Paid lessons given by any others are strictly prohibited.

# **Parties and Facility Rentals**

In order to rent the facility or to make inquiries, please phone 303.840.1187 for the South pool and 720.851.8178 for the North Pool.

## **DAY PARTIES:**

During the daily operation of the facility, residents (21 and older) may host and must accompany small gatherings of **no more than fifteen (15) non-member guests and a maximum of twenty-five (25) people**. Patrons need to phone the appropriate facility and make a reservation through M.P.M. Guest passes must be used for any such gathering. An additional lifeguard will be needed, the party host is responsible for lifeguard fees of \$25 per hour per guard. Reservations must be made at least two weeks in advance. Please observe the party limit for safety reasons and so that other members' usage is not compromised. Other than identified here, the Pool area cannot be blocked for private parties during normal daily operations unless it has been approved by the board of directors. Failure to comply may result in removal of the party from the pool and forfeiture of memberships.

## **EVENING PARTIES:**

Any adult member (21 or older) may rent the facility for evening functions subject to pre-payment of the rental fee and provision of a signed Contract and Facility Use Agreement. Reservations must be made no less than two weeks in advance of the activity and may be made six months in advance on a first come, first served basis. In addition to the rental fee, a \$25 per hour per lifeguard fee will be assessed based on total projected attendance. A minimum of two (2) lifeguards will be required for all evening parties with the need for additional lifeguards to be determined by MPM. Guest Passes must be used for all non-members entering party .

## **NON-PROFIT AND FOR PROFIT ENTITIES**

Use of the pool and facilities by non-profit and for profit entities is not permitted without prior approval of either the Stonegate Village Metropolitan District Board of Directors or the Lincoln Park Metropolitan District Board of Directors. Such approvals by an individual Board are for those facilities that are owned and operated by their respective District and are not to be construed as an approval of the other. Board decisions may be based on any or all of, but not limited to, the following criteria:

1. Potential Health and Safety Concerns
2. Potential Disruption to the Quiet Enjoyment of the facilities by Residents
3. Violations of Occupancy Requirements
4. Resident/Guest Ratio Requirements
5. Entity Compliance History
6. Pool Management Recommendations

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL PARTIES:**

*(Please refer also to the Contract and Use Agreement which contains more specifics.)*

1. A minimum of two lifeguards for two hours is required in order to rent the facility. One lifeguard is required for every additional (25) people. The lifeguard fee is \$25.00/hour per lifeguard. Lifeguard hourly fee is subject to change at any time without prior

notice. The rental fee for the Pool is \$3 per non-member with a required security deposit of \$100.00.

2. The Board or Pool Management Company may use its discretion to increase the number of lifeguards required, or raise the security deposit, depending upon the type of function for which the facility is being used.
3. Evening parties may begin no earlier than 6:30 p.m. Monday through Sunday and parties must end by 10:00 p.m. Set-up may not begin prior to 6:00 p.m. Please note that the hours between 6:00 p.m. and 7 or 8p.m. the pool is open for general use. Please be respectful of other members and their use of the pool until normal closing hours. Please do not move any tables prior to closing.
4. Adult members must be present at the function.
